



Fort Bend Club Scholarship

The Fort Bend Club of The University of Houston Alumni Association is pleased to announce the availability of several \$1,000 scholarships for graduating seniors of high schools in Fort Bend County who have been accepted for admission to the University of Houston.

The Scholarships

The scholarship is a one-year award paid in two installments of \$500, once in the fall semester and once in the spring semester. Recipients must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher to receive the second installment of this award.

Eligibility

Applicant who will be a first time student must be eligible for admission to the University of Houston as a freshman without waiver, on an unconditional basis and must enroll at the University of Houston in the fall semester immediately following high school graduation to receive this scholarship award. This award applies only to the University of Houston and not to the other universities in the UH System (ex. UH-Downtown, UH-Clear Lake, UH-Victoria, and UHS-Sugar Land).

The Fort Bend Club selection committee shall consider academic performance, extracurricular activities, financial need and relationship with UH in making their selections. The committee shall determine the relative weight given to each criterion. There are no restrictions to applicants based on gender, race, nationality, country or origin, physical disability, sexual orientation or veteran status.

Application Deadline

The completed application and a copy of your transcript must be postmarked no later than the deadline stated on www.myCougarConnection.com/scholarships. Please include at least two recommendation letters, one from a teacher and the other from a teacher, advisor, counselor or employer.
